SUBJECT: Emergency Shelter Solutions in East County

Thank you for you and your staff's continued engagement and progress regarding Compassionate Emergency Solutions and Pathways to Housing People Experiencing Homelessness in East County. In an effort to address homelessness in East County, this policy's intention is to empower County staff to work with each community to meet their unique needs. I appreciate staff bringing innovative concepts such as tiny homes, safe car parking, and other shelter solutions for community feedback.

Based on the public input session held in Lakeside on December 1, 2021, and subsequent input my office has received, proposed sites E and F are not preferred by the community. I understand that upon further review by County staff that Site F, known as the "Hay Guy" site, is no longer being considered.

Community members have contacted my office with their support for proposed alternative sites at Channel Road and Maplevue Street, and Riverford Road at Woodside Avenue. I am forwarding the proposed sites to you for your full consideration (Attachment A and B).
