



San Diego City Flood Recovery Weather Support

ISSUED 9 AM, 1/30/2024

Dry and mild through Wednesday. Heavy rain, chances for thunderstorms, and increasing winds on Thursday. Rain will develop in the late morning, becoming heavy at times in the afternoon. More showery and breezy weather expected Friday. Total rainfall 1.5 to 2.5 inches likely, and chance of 3 inches closer to the mountains. Rainfall rates peak at 0.75-1.00 per hour on Thursday. Thunderstorms could bring locally heavier rainfall amounts and rates.
